The Radiation Safety Directorate implements its mission and tasks imposed by legal provisions with regard to nuclear and radiation safety and nuclear security on the basis of the principle stating that **safety is the supreme value.**

Following this principle, everyone at the RSD:

- Aims at ensuring and maintaining full independence and impartiality with regard to the regulatory functions performed.
- Performs their tasks in a professional and competent manner, consistently enforcing compliance of the entities supervised with safety rules.
- Assigns the highest priority to safety, specifying the objectives, planning, implementing and assessing the results of their actions.
- Promotes, implements and develops the safety culture in all areas of activity of the RSD.
- Implements and improves the integrated management system of the RSD and complies with the principles and procedures contained therein.
- Develops their competences, shares knowledge and aims at its preservation and the fullest possible application at work.
- Ensures work safety and protection of material and information resources.
- Cooperates and shares the best practices and knowledge with other entities engaged in peaceful use of nuclear energy and sources of ionizing radiation.
- Maintains transparency in relations of the RSD with the general public, media and other stakeholders.

The management and all employees assume responsibility for implementation of the vision and mission of the RSD in accordance with this Safety Policy and legal provisions in force.

The Management undertakes to provide the necessary resources and personal commitment to the leadership role - acting as a role model, communicating, motivating and supporting employees in effective implementation of the Safety Policy.
